Key instant recall facts (KIRFS) are designed to support the development of key arithmetic skills which underpin much of the maths learning at school. Supporting your child(ren) in learning these facts and being able to recall them quickly will help enormously with progression in maths.

Ways you could help your children to learn these:

Recall square numbers up to 144 and know the notation for squared (2)

1 = 12 or 1 x 1 4 = 22 or 2 x 2 9 = 32 or 3 x 3 16 = 42 or 4 x 4 25 = 52 or 5 x 5 36 = 62 or 6 x 6 49 = 72 or 7 x 7 64 = 82 or 8 x 8 81 = 92 or 9 x 9 100 = 102 or 10 x 10 121 = 112 or 11 x 11 144 = 122 or 12 x 12

Ways you could help your child to learn these:

Playing bingo – linking the squared number to its root

Giving children a number to retell the squared number it would make

Square number tennis- could be verbally or with ball- one person says a number to square, other person says the squared number. Eg- 4 then 16
