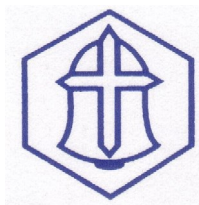


# Mears Ashby School News

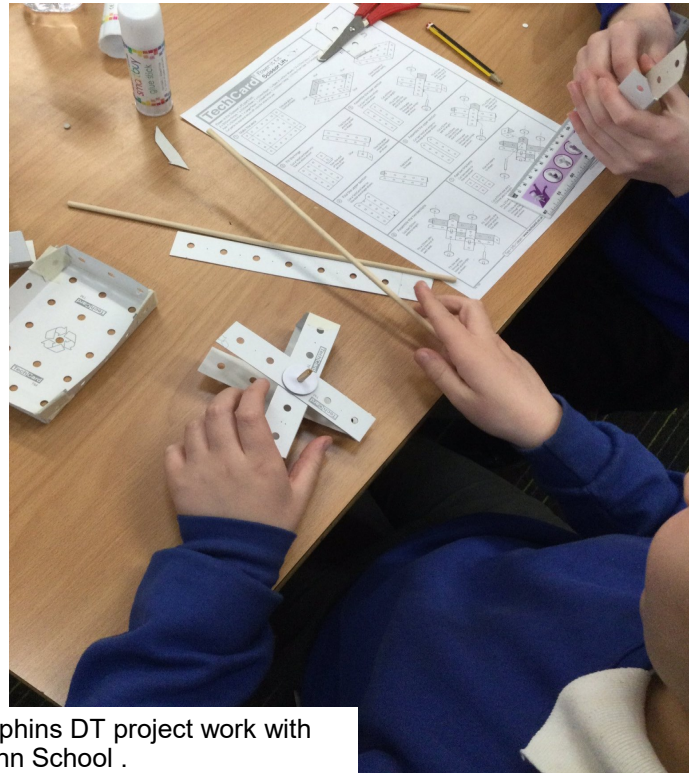
